**Volunteer Job Descriptions**

**EVENT SET UP** – Assists in placing stakes and signage on course (Monday, Tuesday) and assists on Sunday with tear down. May require heavy lifting.

**ECOLOGY** – Distribution of drinks, water, ice; trash collection. May require heavy lifting.

**PRO-AM** (Wed., Thurs.) – Assist in Registration, and shuttling amateurs to and from the range, record stats for long drive and closest to the pin.

**CART DRIVER** – Drives the cart that carries the bags for each threesome, keeps an unofficial score and statistics for each of the players in the group, reports scores to hole reporters at specified holes, and turns in unofficial scores after nine holes. Must be golf knowledgeable

**CHECK-IN** - Register volunteers each day.

**REAL TIME SCORING** – Record unofficial scores and stats obtained from the cart driver, using a PDA.

**COMPUTER OPERATOR** – Input scores for upload to the website.

**RADIO OPERATOR/RECORDER** – Monitor transmissions from the hole reporters.

**DRIVING DISTANCE RECORDER** – Record the length of each player's drive off the tee

**MARSHAL**– Responsible for gallery control and safety..

**SCORING TENT**– Verify final scores of players, get scores recorded.

**SCORECARD RUNNER** - Take players' score cards from scoring tent to tournament office.

**MAIN SCOREBOARD POSTING** – Post scores on the scoreboard.

**LEADERBOARD POSTING** – Update scores on the leaderboard.

**ON COURSE SHUTTLE DRIVER** - Provides shuttle service between specified holes (e.g., between hole 11 and 12) for players.

**SPOTTER** – Assist players in locating ball by spotting where balls landed.

**STANDARD BEARER** – Carry standard sign showing players' scores, keep unofficial score for each player.

**TIMING** – Track the time each group completes the hole, report groups exceeding expected time. Depending on hole assignment, may also perform real time scoring.

**MAIN GATE/TICKET SALES** – Sell tickets and greet spectators as they enter the course

**MEDIA ESCORT** – Drive print and video media around the course as they photograph and video tape play. Course knowledge needed.

**STARTER** – Distribute player scorecards, inform players of any additional information needed, and announce players on the starting tee.

**MARSHALL/ASSISTANT STARTER** – responsible for gallery control on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> tees. Assist starter as necessary.
